He was a member of the Finnish diplomatic service from 1978-1994, a Judge with the Administrative Tribunal of the Asian Development Bank (1997- 2002) member of the International Law Commission (UN) from 2002-2006. His main publications include From Apology to Utopia; The Structure of International Legal Argument (1989/2005), The Gentle Civilizer of Nations: The Rise and Fall of International Law 1870-1960 (2001), The Politics of International Law (2011), and To the Uttermost parts of the Earth. Legal Imagination and International Power 1300-1870 (2021).
