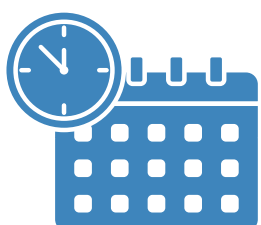

ABSTRACT

International economic law has reached a crisis. The fundamental pillars of the discipline are being questioned and cast aside, and the rules of the game are rapidly changing. While there is broad consensus that contemporary international economic law should be reimagined, disagreements persist about the path forward. This talk reflects on the various approaches and outlines what the future holds for international economic law.
