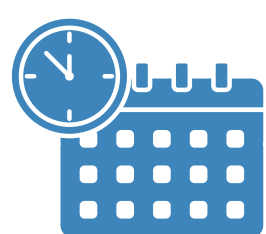
Moderator: Wang Jiangyu
