

Prof. Daniel Pascoe cited in the UN Secretary General’s Report on “Capital punishment and implementation of the safeguards guaranteeing protection of the rights of those facing the death penalty”

Professor Daniel Pascoe, Associate Director of Public Law and Human Rights Forum, has been cited in the UN Secretary General’s Report on “*Capital punishment and implementation of the safeguards guaranteeing protection of the rights of those facing the death penalty*”, which was officially published on 2 June 2025. This report serves as a critical global resource evaluating legal protections and safeguards worldwide.

In addition to this recent recognition, Professor Pascoe was previously cited by the Secretary-General in a 2023 report on the “*Question of the Death Penalty*” submitted to the United Nations Human Rights Council. These successive citations underscore the global reach and policy relevance of Professor Pascoe’s research into capital punishment.
