

CityUHK Team Competes at the 2026 11th International Model UN Universal Periodic Review Competition in Seoul

The Public Law and Human Rights Forum (CPLR) is pleased to announce that our student delegation competed and achieved the **4th Place (Outstanding Delegation Award)** at the **2026 11th International Model United Nations Universal Periodic Review (I-MUN UPR)**. The final round was held on 21 August 2026 at Korea University in Seoul, South Korea.

Co-organized by Human Asia and the Korea University International Human Rights Center, and sponsored by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Korea, the I-MUN UPR is an academic simulation that replicates the UN Human Rights Council's Universal Periodic Review mechanism. The competition brings together selected delegates from across the region to examine pressing human rights challenges and formulate policy recommendations through diplomatic dialogue and formal review procedures.

Out of 24 international delegates, our team, comprising **Aneesabibi Zubair, Belle Tse, and Monica Ka Yu Lam**, delivered an outstanding performance throughout the four rigorous review sessions. Teams were evaluated by a distinguished panel of human rights experts on their substantive knowledge of UN human rights frameworks, public speaking, diplomatic language, and collaborative teamwork.



For their exceptional preparation, thorough understanding of international human rights mechanisms, and strong team spirit, the CityUHK delegation was awarded 4th Place along with an award certificate and a financial prize.
