



## **Professor ZHU Guobin was invited to join the newly established Research Group - “The 25th Anniversary of Hong Kong’s Return to Chinese Sovereignty” – formed by Chinese Association of Hong Kong & Macao Studies**

“One country, two systems” is an innovative policy which has made remarkable contributions in retaining Hong Kong’s institutional settings after the handover. The region’s identity as an international business, financial, shipping and aviation center has been successfully preserved under the policy. Twenty-five years after the handover, the Chinese Association of Hong Kong & Macao Studies decided to form a research group gathering the most prominent scholars which aims to review and analyze Hong Kong’s past experiences in economic, political, legal, social and cultural development, and to look to the future. This research initiative is a national project.
