

# FAQ for Local Freshmen (2025 Entry) at the Ma On Shan Compound

## Hall Admission

**Question 1** I am a prospective local freshman. How can I apply for Student Residence?

Answer: Once your AIMS account is activated, you can apply for Student Residence via AIMS between the period of 13 – 18 August 2025. For details, please refer to [our website](#).

**Question 2** Can I choose both the Kowloon Tong (KLNT) Compound and the Ma On Shan (MOS) Compound or can I choose the KLNT Compound as the 1st priority compound, the MOS Compound as the 2nd priority?

Answer: NO. You can indicate one compound only, i.e. the KLNT Compound or the MOS Compound.

**Question 3** I live in Ma On Shan/ Kowloon Tong or near either one Student Residence, does it mean that I have no chance to live in the Student Residence?

Answer: For those students who are failing to get the hall offer via Score A & B, you still have a chance to get a bedplace by a lottery.

The bedplaces have been increased due to a new Student Residence being operated. Hence, local freshmen who are interested in staying in Student Residence are strongly advised to submit the hall application by 18 August 2025.

**Question 4** Can I change the selected compound?

Answer: YES. Before the application deadline (18 August 2025), you can login to AIMS again to amend. However, no amendment is allowed after the application deadline.

**Question 5** For Score B, I cannot provide any document proof or certification. Is it compulsory to fill in Score B?

Answer: NO, it is NOT compulsory to fill in Score B. You can simply leave it blank on the application form.

**Question 6** What should I do if I don't know my home's size in square feet?

**Question 7** Can I amend the information on the application after submission?

Answer: YES. You can amend your application before the application deadline (i.e. 18 August 2025).

**Question 8** When should I submit my supporting documents for hall application?

Answer: You should submit documents upon request by the Student Residence Office (SRO) from time to time.

**Question 9** How can I accept the hall offer?

Answer: Upon the application result announcement, successful applicants will be required to pay a Hall Confirmation Fee to indicate their acceptance of the hall offer by a specified deadline. The Hall Confirmation Fee is non-refundable and non-transferable. NO bedplace will be reserved if you miss the payment deadline.

**Question 10** If I receive my admission offer from CityU after the application deadline, can I still apply for Student Residence?
