Notification on Emergency Response Unit (ERU) (48)

Over the past few days, the University campus has faced unprecedented security challenges. In this difficult time, as always, we put the safety of all staff and students as top priority and have endeavoured to maintain campus safety.

The University found a large number of highly flammable materials in the student hall area. This material threatens the safety of student residents and staff living and working in the student halls. In addition, some hazardous chemicals were taken by force from our laboratories by several masked intruders.

After comprehensively assessing the situation and risks, we have repeatedly appealed to students to leave the student halls as soon as possible. We have also arranged for vehicles to transport the student residents to leave in groups under safe condition and provided temporary residential arrangements for students who could not return home immediately.

The University also strongly urges all staff and students who still remain in campus areas to pay attention to their personal safety and stay away from danger, as well as to leave campus when circumstances permit. We also urge all not to engage in any dangerous and unlawful activities both on and off campus.

Meanwhile, the University is very grateful to our security staff and critical support colleagues who remain steadfast in their duties maintaining campus safety and operations.
