Notification on Emergency Response Unit (ERU) (49)

The University campus has encountered unprecedented vandalism in recent days. Restoration work will take time. We are very grateful to the heads of different departments who have adopted a flexible work arrangement and to staff who remain steadfast in their duties. They have endeavoured to maintain the operation of the University during this difficult time.

The University puts the safety of students and staff as top priority. After comprehensively assessing campus safety and transportation services, the University announces some special arrangements to be made from 18 to 20 November (next Monday to Wednesday):

- All staff, except for those performing emergency duties, are asked to work from home; services including the University Library, Computing Services Centre, Indra and Harry Banga Gallery and sports facilities will continue to be suspended;
- Supervisors may coordinate work and hold meetings with your team via online platforms from home. You may also call the hotline: 3442 8340 for technical support if necessary;
- According to actual needs, supervisors may request staff to return to their offices for providing essential services. You can call our 24-hour emergency hotline: 3442 8888 for assistance.

Staff and students who are in need or who encounter special circumstances can contact the ERU through Professor Eric Chui, Dean of Students, and the Student Development Services team at enquiry.eru@cityu.edu.hk. The ERU will continue to communicate directly with staff and students and refer enquiries to the corresponding departments for appropriate assistance.
