There have been rumours from various reliable sources that City University of Hong Kong will be the next target for different forms of protests, which is likely to threaten the safety of our staff and students, and cause further damage to our campus and adversely affect our restoration work.

The University campus has also experienced unprecedented vandalism in recent days and so we seek your understanding and cooperation that the University has been forced to impose a number of measures, including enhanced property and security management, temporary closure of campus, including the student residence area.
