### **Preliminary tested positive Covid-19 case Notification from the Emergency Response Unit (ERU) (125)**

The University has been informed that a clerical staff at the Yeung Chung-Yee Health Centre (Medical Clinic) preliminary tested positive for Covid-19 today (11 December). The individual is receiving treatment in the hospital.

It is reported that the individual has had no contact with patients in his/her daily duty, and that he/she has not eaten in the canteens in campus recently. The last time that the individual reported for duty at the Medical Clinic was 7 December. The Medical Clinic suspended all services on 8 December and all the staff are taking Covid-19 tests. Follow-up action has been taken by the University according to guidelines provided by the Centre for Health Protection. All relevant areas of campus had been disinfected and cleaned.
