Confirmed Covid-19 case Notification from the Emergency Response Unit (ERU) (138)

The University was informed earlier today (19 March) that a non-local student was discharged from hospital yesterday (18 March) after recovering from Covid-19 in the individual's home country. The individual has been staying in their home country and has not been on the CityU campus since Semester A 2020/21.

President Way Kuo together with Professor Richard Yuen, Chief-of-Staff, and Professor Eric Chui, Dean of Students, called the student to offer their sincere regards and are pleased to learn that the student has recovered. The student expressed gratitude for the concern and support from the University.

Staff and students are required to report any suspected case to his/her Head if he/she or any direct relative (living together) believe that he/she might be infected.
